In conjunction with Dover and Sandwich Town Councils, we have agreed to rotate our representation, Deal first, Sandwich second and Dover third etc.

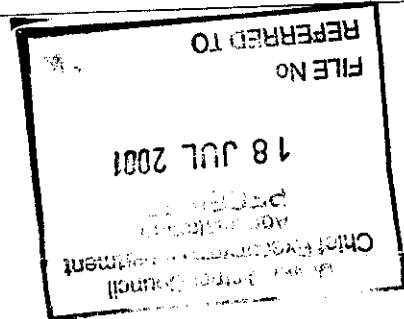

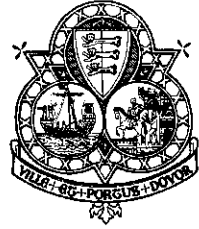

LOCAL GOVERNMENT ACT 2000 STANDARDS COMMITTEE – PARISH REPRESENTATIVES

Thank you for your letter of 30 May 2001 setting out the decision by your Council's Standards Committee about parish representation.

Your letter was considered by the Town Council at its meeting on 20 June 2001. The Town Council resolved that Dover District Council should be requested to reduce the term of appointment for the one Town Council representative on the Standards Committee to one year, and that the Town Mayors of Dover, Deal and Sandwich should be entitled to attend all meetings with one of them having the right to vote by annual rotation. No other decisions were made regarding nominations for representatives and their substitutes.

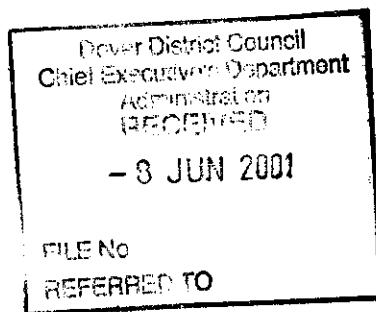

We are assuming that you would not wish to ask for representatives from each Town and Parish, but merely one for all Towns and one for all Parishes.

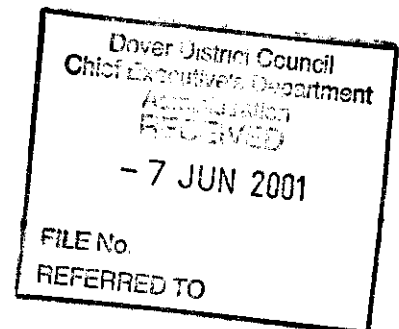

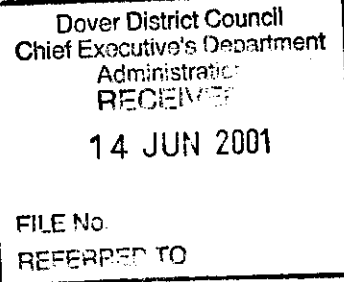

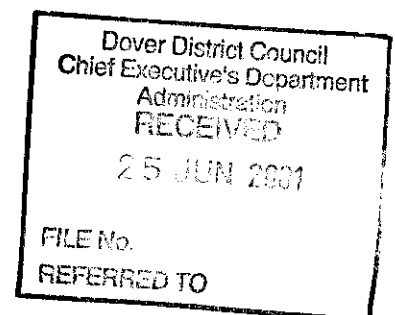
