I&DeA IMPROVEMENT PLAN

- 1. In September of last year, the Improvement and Development Agency were invited by this Council to undertake a review of the whole organisation against their national standard. This review involved the team being with the Council for a week, during which time, they reviewed a considerable number of documents and saw in excess of 200 people including Members, Staff, Partners and Customers. The report that followed and which was received by the Council in December is on balance an excellent one and comments from members of the review team substantiate this view. The report does, however, identify a number of issues that should be addressed and the Improvement Agency require that an Improvement Plan is developed indicating short, medium and long term actions. This Improvement Plan, in draft, has been circulated separately.
- 2. To oversee the implementation and progress of the plan, it is suggested that a cross party Working Group be constituted
