Reason for the Decision:	The Kent Homechoice Partnership was formed in 2008 and a 4-year contract for the IT system to deliver a Choice- Based Lettings system was awarded to Locata Housing Services Ltd in July 2008. This was extended for a further six years to July 2018. It is therefore necessary to award a new contract for the delivery of services post July 2018.
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Decision:	To award the contract for a new Choice-Based Lettings and Housing Options IT system for Kent Homechoice to Locata Housing Services Ltd.

 - 1.2 The Chairman of the Council has agreed to suspend call-in as it is imperative that the outcome of the contract tender can be communicated to the Kent Homechoice partners as quickly as possible. The reason for the urgency is because the new Homelessness Reduction Act Legislation comes into effect on 1 April 2018 which requires our IT system to be updated with a new release which will enable officers to comply with the new legislation. This new release to the system will need to be implemented, tested and all front-line staff across Kent will need to be trained ahead of 1 April 2018.
