- (i) The applicant was willing to comply with the conditions suggested by PC Alexander.

- (iii) The premises would operate a Challenge 21 Policy.

In reaching its finding, the Sub-Committee took into account the following:

- (i) Sections 17 & 18 of the Licensing Act 2003 which deal with applications for premises licence and determination of such applications.
- (ii) The judgement in the case of R. (on the application of Daniel Thwaites PLC) v Wirral Borough Magistrates Court in which it was held that speculative representations should be disregarded unless supported by previous facts as evidence.
- (iii) Guidance issued under s.182 Licensing Act 2003.
- (iv) Dover District Council Licensing Policy.
