### 1. **Consideration and Alternatives** (*if applicable*)

1.1 On 1 July 2019 Cabinet approved in principle to accept a grant of £16.1 million from Homes England to deliver a rapid bus link between the Whitfield Urban Expansion and Dover town centre, now known as Dover Fastrack. The Council entered into a funding agreement with Homes England on 6 November 2019 which specifies that DDC may submit quarterly requests for funding, in accordance with the approved cash flow. This decision notice approves the June 2020 draw-down request of £648,617.
