As per the attached application Kent Police are objecting to this application for the following reasons :-

Under the licensing Objectives of 1. Crime and Disorder 2. Public Safety

- Having looked at the plans there is a concern that tables and chairs are situated across a main road though the town centre. Therefore people will be purchasing alcohol from the public house and then crossing the road to consume this.
- It is not expected there will be a staff member outside at all times therefore there would be very little control on the activities occurring. This raises concerns of levels of consumption of alcohol and potential disorder. As this is a public space it would be hard to control who is consuming alcohol purchased from the venue and bought from local shops.
- During the day these tables will be used by non-customers therefore causing an issue as to the use.

This premises was originally opened up as an off licence however due to the request for wine tasting evenings the application had to include on sales . In a short space of time this has now become a micro style pub and is now seeking extra seating outside . It is not felt this area can be controlled safely or effectively and the fact you have to cross a road carrying alcohol adds to the issues. As people consume alcohol during the evening they become less aware of their surroundings and to cross a road to purchase more alcohol / return glasses would be an accident waiting to happen.
