#### Scrutiny (Community and Regeneration) Committee Recommendations

The Scrutiny (Community and Regeneration) Committee, at its meetings held on 12 October and 14 December 2016, made the following recommendations to Cabinet:

#### 12 October 2016 Recommendations

- (a) That the Head of Regeneration and Development be requested to provide the Committee with the following information:
  - (i) The percentage of applications dealt with in-house and the percentage using private sector contractors.
  - (ii) The number of trainees in the Planning Department.
  - (iii) A copy of the manpower plan for the Planning Department.
- (b) That a system be created to ensure that every planning condition is implemented correctly as per the permission granted.
- (c) That a system of monitoring, with key indicators, be created in respect of all planning conditions.
- (d) That, in the event of a standard planning condition in respect of road surfaces being developed, a copy of the condition be circulated to Members for information.

#### 14 December 2016 Recommendations

- (a) That a review of the Council's Planning Enforcement Plan be undertaken by Quarter 3 of 2017.
- (b) That an outline of the systems in place for planning enforcement be provided to the Scrutiny (Community and Regeneration) Committee.
