the new ward. In addition, Sibertswold is the name of the local primary school in Shepherdswell.





The new ward of Middle Deal is more compact that the original ward and by only containing area within the parish of Deal, provides from a stronger single community identity. The railway line remains as the eastern boundary of the ward. The proposed changes to polling districts AC1 and AB2 would require corresponding changes to the Deal Town Council wards of Middle Deal and Mill Hill.





Rationale:	The lack of road links to polling districts BJ1 (Town and Pier West) and the geographic barrier presented by the Western Heights separate the Maxton and Elms Vale area from its southerly neighbour. A similar lack of road links separates it from the St Radigund's Ward. The only other road connections are a single road into the Tower Hamlets Ward and the stronger connections to the Priory (BF) polling district. The retention of the existing Maxton, Elms Vale and Priory Ward was considered but as this created problems for the electoral equality in other wards and as the ward provides for a good level of electoral equality in 2023 as a single member ward it is therefore proposed that this ward would be best suited to being a single member ward. The initially higher than preferred electoral variance of 10% in 2017 will correct over time as the electorate forecast for polling district BE is static.					
Name Rationale:	In keeping with the technical guidance issued by the LGBCE where a ward remains largely unchanged the existing ward name has been retained. In this case as the Priory polling district (BF) has largely been removed from the Maxton, Elms Vale and Priory Ward it is proposed to name the new ward Maxton and Elms Vale.
