<p><b>Brief Details of Item:</b> (Please provide information about the contents of this item and the reason for decision.)</p> <p>Dover District Council has undertaken a procurement exercise in relation to a complete upgrade of the District's CCTV infrastructure, including a new CCTV control room. At the same time, the exercise looked at the options for introducing public Wi-Fi provision in town centres. The contract provides for the replacement of the current BT Fibre infrastructure to Wi-fi-enabled provision, to carry out works to install a new CCTV Control Room at the Council Offices in Whitfield, and for the provision of publicly-accessible town centre Wi-fi.</p> <p>Cabinet will be requested to: (a) Approve the award of contract for CCTV infrastructure upgrade (including control room upgrade) and provision of town centre Wi-fi; and (b) Approve additional spend (associated project costs).</p>
