Brief Details of Item:

On 1 July 2019 Cabinet agreed to accept a grant of £16.1m from Homes England with the purpose of delivering a Bus Rapid Transit (BRT) link between the Whitfield Urban Expansion and Dover town. Cabinet also authorised the Strategic Director (Operations and Commercial), in consultation with the Portfolio Holder for Transport and Licensing, to negotiate terms, enter into and execute the necessary land transactions, as long as the costs of such actions fall within the grant awarded by Homes England. Rights have been secured over the majority of the land required to deliver BRT and the Council continues to engage in positive dialogue with landowners to the north of the A2 but these negotiations have not reached a conclusion. The purpose of this report is to update Cabinet on progress and to seek authority for exploring options regarding Compulsory Purchase Orders to deliver the project.

Homes England has already extended the deadline for completing the Funding Agreement by several months and has advised that if it is not signed before the end of September there is a risk that the money may be reallocated to other government projects.
