The BFG Grant can be allocated as either a grant or a loan depending on the implications for state aid, nature of use and level of investment to be made. The AMR can also be used to propose changes to the Local Development Scheme, capture levels of housebuilding across the District, report on progress of the delivery of the Council's Strategic Land Allocations and monitor levels of development funding received for infrastructure provision.	 14/10/19

The LDS is a public statement that sets out the programme that Dover District Council intends to follow in the production of its Local Development Framework over the next three years. The timetable and milestones contained within the LDS are monitored annually as part of the Authority Monitoring Report (AMR).</p> <p>This LDS supersedes the Council's previous LDS which was published in May 2018. It has been updated to take into account changes to the preparation, consultation and adoption of:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • District Local Plan; and • A number of Conservation Area Character Appraisals. 	 14/10/19
24	Refurbishment of Tides Leisure Centre, Deal	January 2020	<p>The Council has commissioned consultants to further investigate preferred options and costs regarding the proposed refurbishment and extension of Tides Leisure Centre in Deal. The need for wet and dryside improvements, including pool water space, fitness and aerobic provision, is supported by the Indoor Sport Facility Strategy. At Cabinet's meeting in July 2018, it requested that a further report be submitted on the preferred options with various recommendations for overall improvements. A Cabinet decision is required to decide whether the project should progress to the next phase and develop detailed design and procurement plans for the potential delivery.</p>	 14/10/19

28	Coastal Communities Fund grant for rejuvenation of Market Square, Dover	2 December 2019 (9 December 2019 Scrutiny)	In January 2019 the Council submitted a bid on behalf of Dover Town Team Ltd to the Ministry of Housing, Communities and Local Government Coastal Communities Fund for improving access and public realm at the Market Square and Old Town in Dover. The objective of the project being to repurpose Dover's historic Market Square as a hub connecting the local community and tourists alike with the town, and the proposals were subject to public consultation in 2018. A grant of £2.4 million was awarded on 1 October 2019 which will be paid to the Council as the accountable body for the project, under powers contained in section 31 of the Local Government Act 2003. The Council will therefore administer the project to deliver the physical works, liaising with the Town Team as the grant applicant. An associated programme of seasonal events in the Market Square and Old Town will be delivered by the Town Team.	 11/11/19
