- 3.1 In March it became apparent that the Covid-19 outbreak was having a significant impact on parking demand across the District and the decision was taken to suspend charges within the Council's off-street car parks and on-street parking bays. Now that some of the lockdown restrictions are being lifted, demand is increasing, and it is appropriate to reintroduce charges.
- 3.2 It is therefore proposed that, in accordance with Paragraph 17 of the Dover District Council (Off-Street Parking Places) Order 2019 and the provisions within the Kent County Council (Various Roads, Dover District) (Waiting Restrictions and Street Parking Places) Order 2005, charges within the off-street car parks and on-street parking bays managed by the Council are reintroduced with immediate effect. This

includes the car parks managed by the Council on behalf of English Heritage at Walmer and Deal Castles, subject to the agreement of English Heritage.
