Overage report

Spoken to Mr Lawrence today and inspected a Skoda Octavia, blue /grey colour, registration BT11 FCJ. The car was presented in a clean condition and photographs were taken. The vehicle has covered 191,889 miles and Mr Lawrence has told me the vehicle has been well maintained, mostly by Elms Vale garage, Dover. I have asked him to collate any service history and repair invoices that he has for this car and bring them with him on the day of the hearing.

There were some paint defects visible such as stone chips to the bonnet, a previous repair to the NSF door and the OSR bumper corner was protruding slightly.

In general, the condition of the car for its age and mileage was acceptable for use as a taxi and it will be for the committee to decide whether it can be used as such due to the policy requirements.
