<p>Brief Details of Item:</p> <p>The Ash Neighbourhood Development Plan 2018-2037 underwent independent examination between February and May 2021. The Examiner concluded that, subject to the modifications set out in his report, the Plan meets the basic conditions and other legal requirements, and that the Plan should proceed to referendum. On 1 June 2021 Ash Parish Council formally submitted the referendum version of the Plan incorporating the Examiner's modifications and, on 8 June 2021, the Council issued a decision to send the Plan to referendum, with the referendum being held on 22 July 2021.</p> <p>Should the majority (greater than 50%) in the referendum vote for Dover District Council to use the Ash Neighbourhood Development Plan to help it decide planning applications in the neighbourhood area, then the Council must make the Plan.</p>			
<p>Deadline for Item:</p> <p>The Neighbourhood Planning (General) and Development Management (Amendment) Regulations 2016 sets out the statutory requirement for the Council to 'make' the Ash Neighbourhood Development Plan within 8 weeks from the day after the referendum. This means that if the Ash Neighbourhood Development Plan referendum is successful, then the Council must make the Plan by 17 September 2021.</p>
