Public Spaces Protection Orders – Consultation.

Introduction

Dover District Council is seeking the views of residents, businesses and community groups throughout the District on proposals to review and amend existing Public Spaces Protection Orders (PSPO). These relate to dog control and consumption of alcohol in public places.

It is proposed to add additional controls in relation to unauthorised camping,

The Anti-social Behaviour, Crime and Policing Act 2014.

This Act gives Council's the power to create PSPOs. The intention is to make the above matters an offence

Dover District Council accepts that the vast majority of those living in, working in and visiting the District are caring responsible people who take steps to ensure their behaviour or that of their pets does not cause distress or harm to others. However there are a minority who do create problems and the proposed controls are intended to address this.

It is important the Council takes the views of its citizens and those affected by these proposals into account. We therefore invite your representations on the proposals.

All representations made will be considered and may result in amendments being made to the draft PSPO. If significant amendments are made further notification will take place.
