Brief Details of Item:

The Regulator of Social Housing, Tenant Involvement and Empowerment Standard requires registered providers of social housing to ensure that their tenants are given a wide range of opportunities to influence and be involved in their services. This includes opportunities to scrutinise their performance, be involved in the formulation of housing-related policies and strategic priorities and helping to make decisions about how housing-related services are delivered, including the setting of service standards.
