<p><b>Brief Details of Item:</b> (Please provide information about the contents of this item and the reason for decision.)</p> <p>On 27 June 2020, following a tender exercise, the Council awarded a 5-year buildings insurance contract to Ocaso for the Council's leasehold/Right-to-Buy (RTB) properties. However, Ocaso have decided to withdraw from the UK insurance market but have agreed to honour the current contract until the next renewal date of 30 June 2022. There is a need to tender for a new insurance provider for the remaining 3-year period. This will ensure that cover coincides with the Council's main programme of insurance so that everything can be tendered together again in the future.</p>			
<p><b>Deadline for Item:</b> (Please indicate the date and whether this is statutory, operational or to meet the requirements of another agency.)</p> <p>11 May 2022 - The tenders are to be evaluated between 23 and 30 April, followed by a 30-day consultation period with leaseholders in accordance with Section 20 (as above).
