RE: Application to place table and chairs on the Highway at Crispin inn, 4 High Street, Sandwich, CT13 9EA

I'm writing to object to this planning proposal for the following reasons:

<!--[if !supportLists]-->1) <!--[endif]-->My house is on the highway of the proposed location for the request. It's a narrow public footpath that also provides vehicular access to 2 private properties.

<!--[if !supportLists]-->2) <!--[endif]-->Allowing tables outside will invite the Crispin's customers to sit on the wall whilst the tables are out on the footpath. It will be difficult to regulate and I'm concerned that the tables will be used by groups to place drinks on whilst standing outside on the path.

<!--[if !supportLists]-->3) <!--[endif]-->It's a foot path used by the public and dog walkers, which might cause issues if food is served outside.

<!--[if !supportLists]-->4) <!--[endif]-->It sets a precedent for other establishments (The Toll Bridge Bar & Restaurant), who have already placed 3 tables and 6 chairs outside on the public footpath without Council / Licensing approval as their notification letter for proposed seating outside is approximately a week or so behind the Crispin's application.

I look forward to hearing the decision made by the licensing section.
