DOVER JOINT TRANSPORTATION ADVISORY BOARD – 30 JUNE 2022

DORMAN AVENUE SOUTH, AYLESHAM: PROPOSED REVISION OF DOUBLE YELLOW LINE PARKING RESTRICTIONS

Recommendation:

The Board is asked to agree that:

- (a) The existing Double Yellow Lines parking restrictions be extended to allow safer entry/egress from Dorman Avenue South and Market Place.
- (b) Extend and install corner protection restrictions on Milner Crescent and Hyde Place, on to Dorman Avenue.
- (c) Install Double Yellow Lines at the entrance to Greyhound Gardens.

Reasons why a decision is required

1. We have been approached by Aylesham Parish Council, along with residents to review the current parking arrangements and the issues of access on to and from Dorman Avenue South.
2. We're proposing that there be a revision to this area and install further restrictions to allow the free flow of traffic. As per the attached drawing Appendix A.
3. In making this recommendation, consideration has been given to equality issues. It is not anticipated that these proposals will adversely affect any of the groups having protected characteristics contrary to the Equalities Act 2010.
4. The additional restrictions will have little impact on blue badge holders.
5. The Board is asked to consider whether the proposal detailed in this report be further investigated on its viability.
6. Evaluation of options available to the Board:
 - To agree to recommendation and apply for a TRO to be created
 - To withdraw the proposal
