Dear

Over recent years, Dover District Council's Parking Services has received correspondence from local residents and local councillors expressing their concern at the availability of parking along the roads in Coombe Valley Road, MacDonald Road, and Lambton Road, even with a zone K residents permit.

To be able to resolve this matter, we propose to introduce a 2-hour maximum stay Cashless Pay to Park Restriction for non-permit holders in these areas.

I am taking a report to the Dover Joint Transportation Board (JTAB), which only has an advisory role, in June 2022. The focus of the concerns will be;

- (a) That consultation be undertaken on the following proposal: That a Cashless pay to park restriction be installed in the above roads from 9.00am to 6.00pm, Monday to Saturday, with permit holders also being able to park, as they do at the moment, without further payment,
- (b) That the consultation should include a question on whether other parking restrictions are a better option.

I am therefore writing to invite you to take part in this consultation on the proposal to introduce controls on the parking

The suggested area to be covered by the restriction is as set out on the attached plan.

Current Single Yellow Line (SYL) parking restrictions to be changed to Double Yellow Lines. This is to maintain passing places at all times and days of the week.
