DOVER JOINT TRANSPORTATION ADVISORY BOARD – 30 JUNE 2022

DOVER: PROPOSED REVISION OF RESIDENTS' PERMIT PARKING SCHEME TIMES

Recommendation:

The Board is asked to agree that:

The existing Zones A to G residents' permit parking schemes restriction times to be changed from 8.30am–5.30pm to 7.00am–8.00pm.

Reasons why a decision is required

1. The change in restriction times would allow residents in possession of a residents parking permit, a greater period that non-residents permit holders would have to respect the restriction times and be able to park.
2. Each of the properties within the Dover area, that are able to apply for a permit had been sent a letter on the 27th April 2022, explaining the proposed changes and with it, a questionnaire to be filled in and returned by the 20th May 2022. Appendix A.
3. A drawing of those able to apply for a permit was included. Appendix B + B1
4. Responses from the residents have been collated Appendix C.
5. Zones A to G and Business permits will remain unchanged.
6. In making this recommendation, consideration has been given to equality issues. It is not anticipated that these proposals will adversely affect any of the groups having protected characteristics contrary to the Equalities Act 2010.
7. The additional restrictions will have little impact on blue badge holders as they can continue to park for free with no time limit on-street.
8. The Board is asked to consider whether the proposal detailed in this report for the revised times for the residents permit zone be implemented.
9. Evaluation of options available to the Board:
 - To agree to the recommendation of changing the restriction times from 8.30am – 5.30pm to 7am – 8pm and taken to formal consultation.
 - To withdraw the proposal of the revised times.
