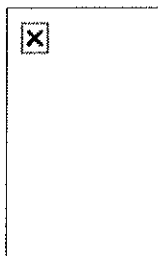

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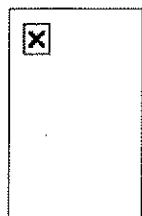



Application to trade between 09.00 hours and 16.00 hours every day selling food and drinks.


I write in connection with the above application to trade. I have examined the trade plans and I know the location detailed in the plans. I wish to strongly object to the consent to trade in food and drinks at this location.

I own the café La Salle Verte in Cannon Street, which is very close to the proposed site. This new street trading could potentially affect my business. There are already a number of cafes and food and beverage establishments in the town, the majority of which are in the Market Square area and the lower end of Cannon Street. I therefore do not think this is the suitable location for another outlet for food and drink, bearing in mind we are barely profitable now.

I am also concerned that the location for application to trade is currently often inhabited by a number of local drunks, who often cause disruptions and unsightly scenes in the Market Square. An outside street trader may unintentionally encourage the alcoholics to continue loitering in this area, and cause additional problems. We have previously had trouble from this particular group of alcoholics who have hung around in the alley way behind La Salle Verte in Cannon Street, as well as falling over in the street, being sick in the street and cause disruptions by shouting and arguing. I hope this is taken into consideration, as the Market Square area is one of the first places in town that tourists see and therefore needs to look presentable and friendly.
