

Motions on Notice by Members

(1) In accordance with Council Procedure Rule 13, Councillor C S Zosseder will move:

- To call upon the council to reject First Past the Post, the voting system currently used for General Elections, and to support the introduction of a form of Proportional Representation in which all votes count equally and seats match votes.
- To request that the Leader writes to H.M. Government calling for a change in our outdated electoral laws to enable Proportional Representation to be used for general elections and follow the Welsh Government example of allowing English Councils to use a PR system
- to sign up to the Electoral Reform Society petition calling for Fair votes in English local government
- to form an all-party group (including political parties active in Dover District but who do not have any councillors) to lobby Government for the right for English local government to choose a PR option for elections, working with the Electoral Reform Society, Make Votes Matter and other organisations dedicated to introducing PR at all levels of UK Government.

(2) In accordance with Council Procedure Rule 13, Councillor H M Williams will move:

“DDC councillors completely oppose fracking in any land within our council area, and will oppose any planning application for this.”
