<p><b>Brief Details of Item:</b> (Please provide information about the contents of this item and the reason for decision.)</p> <p>Under the Clean Neighbourhoods and Environment Act 2005, local authorities have certain powers to tackle environmental crime, including the use of fixed penalty notices as an alternative to prosecution. The Environmental Crime Team have utilised various service delivery methodologies since Cabinet agreed to adopt a more robust approach to environmental crimes such as littering and dog fouling in 2012. This has included the use of both internal resources and external contractors. This report seeks a renewed decision from Members regarding the future direction of service delivery of litter enforcement across the district.</p>
