Dear Sir

I am attaching a petition I have organised to restore the original Wave Sculpture that was removed from the end of Deal Pier in 2019, apparently for repairs.

This sculpture, which features on post cards of Deal pier, and on a blown-up photograph in Deal Library, is considered by many Deal residents to be an integral and impressive feature of the pier, and framed the clock in a pleasing way , and complimented the Fisherman sculpture in front of the pier entrance.

I have ascertained from the Nailbourne Forge in Littlebourne that the repairs needed when the sculpture was removed were insignificant, and the Forge submitted a reasonable quote to complete them, but apparently no further contact from the Council was made. This means the current whereabouts of the sculpture are a bit of a mystery.

As residents of Deal, we would like to press the Council to take action to discover the current whereabouts of the artwork, and to restore it to the pier entrance as soon as possible.
