21 LICENSING ACT 2003 - REGARDING MAGISTRATES' COURT APPEAL FOLLOWING THE APPLICATION FOR THE REVIEW OF A PREMISES LICENCE FOR THE ATTIC BAR, FIRST AND SECOND FLOORS, 8-9 CHURCH STREET, DOVER

The Licensing Sub-Committee was asked to review the number permitted in the outside smoking area as per the decision made by the Licensing Sub-Committee on 3 March 2023 in respect of the review of the premises licence for The Attic Bar, First and Second Floors, 8-9 Church Street, Dover.

The Sub-Committee had regard to and took into account the Licensing Manager's report, oral submissions and the options available to the Sub-Committee.

In reaching its findings the Sub-Committee had taken into account:

- (i) Dover District Council's Licensing Policy

- (iii) Article 6 of the Human Rights Act (Right to a fair trial)
- (iv) Section 17 of the Crime and Disorder Act 1998 (Duty to consider crime and disorder implications)
