<p>Brief Details of Item: (Please provide information about the contents of this item and the reason for decision.)</p> <p>The Homelessness Act 2002 and the Homelessness Code of Guidance (for Local Authorities) stipulates that local authorities are required to develop and publish a strategy every 5 years (or sooner) on how it will address homelessness and rough sleeping in its area. This strategy must be informed by a review of homelessness and rough sleeping in the district and developed in collaboration and consultation with public authorities, homelessness service providers and service users.</p> <p>The Council has an established Homelessness and Rough Sleeping Strategy (2020-2024), however this now requires a review and update. The new Strategy will cover the period between 2025-2030 and sets out the Council's key priorities for tackling and reducing homelessness and rough sleeping through preventative actions and multi-agency working.</p>
